

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

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KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned persons of the age of eighteen (18) years or more, at least the majority of whom are residents of the State of Nevada and citizens of the United States, do hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a nonprofit corporation under the statutes of the State of Nevada.

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of the corporation shall be:

ARTICLE III

DURATION

The period of the duration of this corporation is fifty (50) years from the date of incorporation.

ARTICLE IV

PURPOSES AND POWERS OF THE ASSOCIATION

This corporation does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit to the members thereof, and the specific purposes for which it is formed are to provide for maintenance, preservation and architectural control of the fourplex townhouse located on that certain real property in the County of Douglas, State of Nevada, more particularly described on Exhibit "A", which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, and to promote the health, safety and welfare of the residents within

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the above-described property and any additions thereto as may hereafter be brought within the jurisdiction of this association, and for this purpose to:

- Exercise all of the powers and privileges and to perform all of the duties and obligations of the Association as set forth in that certain Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions, hereinafter called "the Declaration", applicable to the property and recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Douglas County, Nevada, and as the same may be amended from time to time as therein provided; said Ddeclaration being incorporated herein as is set forth at length;
- (b) Fix, levy, collect and enforce payment by any lawful means of all charges or assessments pursuant to the terms of the Declaration, to pay all expenses in connection therewith, and all office and other expenses incident to the conduct of the business of the Association, including all licenses, taxes or governmental charges levied or imposed against the property of the Association:
- (c) Acquire (by gift, purchase or otherwise), own, hold, improve, build upon, operate, maintain, convey, sell, lease, transfer, dedicate for public use or otherwise dispose of real or personal property in connection with the affairs of the Association;
- Borrow money, and with the assent of two-thirds (2/3) of each class of members, mortgage, pledge, deed in trust, or hypothecate any or all of its real or personal property as security for money borrowed or debts incurred;
- (e) Participate in mergers and consolidations with other non-profit corporations organized for the same purposes or annex additional residential property, provided that any such merger, consolidation or annexation shall have the assent of twothirds (2/3) of each class of members;

(f) Have and to exercise any and all powers, rights and privileges which a corporation organized under the non-profit corporation law of the State of Nevada (NRS 81.010 et seq.) by law may now or hereafter have or exercise.

ARTICLE V

MEMBERSHIP

Every person or entity who is a record owner of a fee or undivided fee interest in and to one of the units located at 200 County, Douglas County, Nevada, including contract sellers, shall be a member of the Association. The foregoing is not intended to include persons or entities who hold an interest merely as security for the performance of an obligation. Membership shall be appurtenant to, and may not be separated from, ownership of any lot which is subject to assessment by the Association.

VOTING RIGHTS

The Association shall have two (2) classes of voting membership, Class A and Class B. Class A members shall be all owners, with the exception of the declarant (as defined in the Declaration) and shall be entitled to one (1) vote for each unit owned. When more than one person holds an interest in a unit, all such persons shall be members. The vote for such unit shall be exercised as they among themselves determine, but in no event shall more than one (1) vote be cast with respect to any unit. Class B members shall be the declarant and shall be entitled to three (3) votes for each unit owned. The Class B membership shall cease and be converted to Class A membership on the happening of either of the following events, whichever occurs earlier:

(a) When the total votes outstanding in the Class A membership equal the total votes outstanding in the Class B membership, or

(b) January 1, 1979.

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ARTICLE VII

NON-STOCK CORPORATION

The corporation shall be non-stock, and no dividends or pecuniary profits shall be declared or paid to the members thereof.

ARTICLE VIII

BOARD OF DIRECTORS

· The affairs of this Association shall be managed by a Board
ofdirectors, (pursuant to NRS 81.040(6), there must
be at least three (3) directors), who must be members of the
Association. The number of directors may be changed by amendment
of the By-Laws of the Association. The names and addresses of

ARTICLE IX

AMENDMENTS

Amendment of these Articles shall require the assent of twothirds (2/3) of the entire membership.

The By-Laws of the Association may be amended by a twothirds (2/3) majority vote of the Board of Directors.

This corporation reserves the right to amend, alter, change or repeal any provision contained in these Articles of Incorporation, in the manner now or hereafter prescribed by the laws of the State of Nevada, and all rights conferred upon the officers and directors herein are granted subject to this reservation.
