Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest additional amount addition to tax or assessable penalty together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a field its favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another dige is specifically fixed by law, the benumposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the katality for the amount so assessed for a judgment against the taxpager arising out of such Satistal is situated to become upenforceable by courter of labora of time

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

- (a) Purchasers, Halders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lieners, And Judgment Lien Creditors. - The lien imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest mechanic's Henor, or judgment ben creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary
- (b) Protection For Cortain Interests Even Though Notice Filed. -- Even though notice of a lien imposed by section 6321 has been filed, such lien shall not be valid-
 - (1) Place For Filing Notice: Form,-
- (1) Place for filling ... The notice referred to in subection (a) shall be filed-
 - (A) Under State Laws ~
 - (i) Real Property -- In the case of real property, in one affice within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the taws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and
 - (ii) Personal Property --- to-the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or this county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated, or
- (B) With Clerk Of District Court -in the office of the cters of the United States district court for the judicial district hich the property subject to hen is situated, wherever the State has not by two designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A); or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District of Columbia -- In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the lien is subsited in the District of Columbia

- (2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien. -- For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be
- (A) Real Property, --In the case of real property, at its physical location; o
- (B) Personal Property -- in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxpayer at the time the notice of ben is filed For purposes of paragraph (2)(B), the residence of a corporation or partnership shaft be deemed to be the place at which the principal executive office of the business is located. and the residence of a taxpayer whose residence is without the United States shall be dremed to be in the District of Constitution
- (3) Form The form and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid notwithstanding any other provision of law regarding the form or content of a notice of lien
- (g) Refilling Of Natice.—For purpose of this section-
- (1) General Rule .- Unless notice of hen is refiled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refiling period, such notice of lien shall be treated as fined on the date on which it is filled (in accordance with subsections (f)) after the supiration of such refiling period
- (2) Place For Filling.—A notice of hen refiled during the required refining period shall be effective only-
 - (A) If such notice of hen is refiled in the office in which the prior notice of hen was filed, and
- (B) in any case in which 90 days or more prior to the date of a retiting of notice of tien under subparagraph (A), the Sucretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concern-State in which such residence is located

- (3) Required Refiling Period.—In the case of any notice of Ren, the term "required reliking period" means-
- (A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and
- (B) the one year period ending with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the proceding required refising period for such notice of hen
- Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.
- (a) Release Of Lien. Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall essue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not taler than 30 days after the day on which-
- is 1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable —The Secretary finds that the hability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become legally unenforceable; or
- (2) Bond Accepted -There is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, within the time prescribed by law (including any extension of such time), and that is in accordance with such requirements relating to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and sureties thereon, as may be specified by such regulations
