## Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person hable to pay any tax reprects or refuses to pay the same after derhand, the amount (including any interest additional amount, addition to tirk, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a tien in layer of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to sach person

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Universiancement date is specifically fixed by tain, the lien in posed by section 6321 shall arbe at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the bability for the amount so assessed (or a publiment against the taxpayer arising out of such kability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason. of Laboral of Lemma

## Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons

- (a) Purchasers, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lieners, And Judgment Lien Creditors. - The ken imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest. mechanic's Benor, or judgment ben creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary
- (b) Protection For Cortain Interests Even Though Notice Filed. - Even though notice of a ten imposed by section 6121 has been filed, such lien shall not be valid-Place For Filing Notice; Form. -

(1) Place For Filling -- The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filled-

(A) Under State Laws -

(i) Neal Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental sundivision), as designated by the laws of such State in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(a) Personal Property -- in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangole, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental aubdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the properly subject to the lien is situated, or

(B) With Clerk Of District Court - in the office of the cters of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lies is situated, when State has not by time designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District of Columbia -- in the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of Columbia

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien. -- For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be

(A) Real Property; - in the case of real property, at its physical location, or

(B) Personal Property - in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxpayer at the time the solice of lien is filed for purposes of paragraph (2)(8), the residence of a corporation or partnership shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal executive office of the business is located and the residence of a taxpayer whose residence is without the United States shall be deemed to be in the District of Common

(3) Form - The form and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary Such notice shall be valid notwithstanding any other provision of law regarding the form or content of a notice of Sen-

(g) Reffling Of Notice.—For purpose of this section-

(1) General Rule,-Unless notice of lien is refiled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refiling period, such notice of lien shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such rehing period

(2) Place For Filling,-A notice of hen refined during the required refling period shall be effective only-(A) If such notice of lien is relided in the office in which the

prior notice of tien was blind, and

(B) in any case in which 90 days or more prior to the date of a refiling of notice of hen under subparagraph (A). the Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning alchange in the taxpayer's residence, if a notice of such then its also filled in accordance with subsection (I) in the property such State in which such residence is located to the property. (3) Required Refilling Period. -- in the case of any notice of lien, the term "required refiling period" means-

(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and

(8) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the preceding required refining period for such notice of heri-

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien, -- Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any fien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which...

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been tuby satisfied or has

become legally unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted -There is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, within the time prescribed by law (including any extension of such time), and that is in accordance with such requirements relating to ferms, conditions, and form of the bond and sureties thereon, as may be specified by such regulations

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and disclosure of returns and return information.

(k) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purpeses. --

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding liers -if a notice of iten has been filed pursuant to section 6323(1), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who turnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such
