Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or reluses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to late, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a Ben in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by faw, the fien impozed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment its made and shall continue until the Rability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of tapse of time

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

- (a) Purchasers, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors,—The lien imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any punchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lience, or progress less predict unil notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary
- (b) Protection For Certain Interests Even Though Notice Filed. - Even though notice of a lien imposed by section 6321 has been filed, such fien shall not be valid-
- (f) Place For Filing Notice: Form, (1) Flace For Fiting -The notice relented to in subsection (a) shall be filed-

(A) Under State Laws -

(i) Real Property — in the case of real property. In one office within the State (or the county, or other governmenful subdivision), as designated by the taws of such Siate, in which the property subject to the fen is situated; and

(B) Personal Property - In the case of personal properly, whether tang ble or inlang ble, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the properly subject to the Ben is situated, or

(B) With Clerk Of District Court - In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District of Columbia -In the cifice of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of Columbia

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien. - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be SEEDING -

(A) Real Property - in the case of real property, at its physical location, or

(B) Personal Property—In the case of personal property, whether rangible or inlangible, at the residence of the laxpayer at the time the netice of lien is filled. For purposes of paragraph (2)(B), the residence of a corporation or partnership shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal executive office of the business is located. and the residence of a taxpayer whose residence is without the United States shall be deemed to be in the District of Columbia

(3) Form —The form and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary Such notice shall be valid notwithstanding any other provision of law regarding the form or content of a notice of lien

- (g) Relating Of Hotice.—For purpose of this section-
- (1) General Rule .- Unless notice of lien is relied in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required relling period, such notice of Ren shall be treated as fixed on the date on which it is fixed (in accordance with

subsection (I) after the expiration of such retaing period.

(2) Place For Filing.—A notice of lien relied during the required reiding period shall be effective only—(A) If such notice of Ben is relied in the office in which the

prior notice of lien was filed, and

(B) In any case in which 90 days or more prior to the date of a refung of notice of lien under subparagraph (A), the Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpayer's residence, if a notice of such Een is also ided in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is located.

(3) Required Reliling Period.—In the case of any notice of lien, the term "required retiling period" means—
(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the

expiration of 6 years after the date of the assetsment of the tax, and

(B) the one-year period ending with the experation of 6 years after the close of the preceding required relicing period for such notice of tien

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

- (a) Release Of Lien.—Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on
- (1) Liability Salished or Upenforceable —The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become legally unenforceable; or
- (2) Bond Accepted -There is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, within the time prescribed by law (including any extension of such time), and that is in accordance with such requirements relating to terms, conditions. and from oil the bond and surelies thereon, as may be specified by such regulations

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and disclosure of returns and return information.

- (k) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes .-
- (2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding tien—If a notice of tien has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a night in such property

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
