Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

- (a) Purchasers, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors.—The ten expected by section 521 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest. mechanit s tener or progress len credit until notice thereof which mee's the requirements of subsection (I) has been filed by the Secretary
- (b) Protection For Certain Interests Even Though Notice Filed.—Even though notice of a lien impaced by sec-tion 6321 has been liked, such lien shall not be valid—
- (f) Place For Filing Notice: Form.— (1) Place for Fring -The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed-

(A) Under State Laws -

(i) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision) as designated by the laws of such State. in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and (ii) Personal Property —in the case of personal proper-

ty, whether langible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision). as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated, or

(B) With Clerk Of District Court - In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the

requirements of subparagraph (A); or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District of Columbia.—In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of Columbia

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien -For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated -

(A) Real Property. —In the case of real property, at its

physical location, or

(B) Personal Property - In the case of personal properly, whether langible or intangible, at the residence of the laxpayer at the time the notice of lien is filed For purposes of paragraph (2)(8), the residence of a corporation or partnership shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal executive office of the business is located. and the residence of a laxpayer whose residence is without the United States shall be deemed to be in the District of Columbia

(3) Form —The form and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary Such notice shall be valid notwithstanding any other provision of law regarding the form or content of a notice of ten

(g) Reliling Of Notice.—For purpose of this section-

(1) General Rule.-Unless notice of lien is relifed in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required reliling period, such notice of lien shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with

subsection (I)) after the expiration of such reliting period.

(2) Place For Filling.—A notice of lien relited during the required reliting period shall be effective only—

(A) If such notice of lien is reliked in the office in which the

prior notice of lien was filed, and

(B) In any case in which 90 days or more prior to the date of a retiting of notice of then under subparagraph (A), the Secretary received written Information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpayer's residence, if a notice of such lien is also filed in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is located REQUESTED BY

(3) Required Reliting Period.—In the case of any notice of lien, the term "required reliting period" means—
(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the
