Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or reluses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assossable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) stall be a lien in layer of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such desson.

Sec. 6322, Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is appointed by law, the lief the pailed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the Rabilty for the amount so assenced (or a pudgment against the laxipayer arising cut of each habilty is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

- (a) Purchasers, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors,—The Beneropesed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, bedder of a security interest mechanic s Benor, or judgment fen creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (i) has been tiled by the Secretary
- (c) Protection For Certain Interests Even Though Notice Filed,—Even though notice of a fen imposed by section 6321 has been liked, such liep shall not be valid—
- (f) Place For Filing Notice: Form.—
 (i) Place For Filing —The notice referred to in sub-

section (a) shall be liked— (A) Under State Laws—

(i) Real Property—In the case of real property, in one office within the State for the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the Laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is shuated; and

(ii) Personal Property — In the case of personal property, where tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated, or

(B) With Clerk Of District Court.—In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A); or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District of Columbia.—In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of Columbia.

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien —For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated—

(A) Real Property.—In the case of real property, at its chysical location, or

(B) Personal Property—In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intengible, at the residence of the taxpayer at the time the notice of lien is filled for purposes of paragraph (2)(B), the residence of a corporation or partnership shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal executive office of the fusiness is located, and the residence of a taxpayer whose residence is without the United States shall be deemed to be in the District of Countria.

t3) Form —The farm and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary Such notice shall be valid notwithstanding any either provision of time resarding the farm or content of a notice of ties.

(g) Reliling Of Holice.—For purpose of this section-

(1) General Rule.—Unless notice of lien is relied in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required relieng period, such notice of lien shall be treated as fixed on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such relicing period.

(2) Place For Filling.—A notice of lien reliked during the required relizing period shall be effective only—

(A) If such notice of lien is reliked in the office in which the

prior notice of tien was filed; and

(8) In any case in which 90 days or more prior to the date of a refiling of notice of lien under subparagraph (A), the Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpayer's residence, if a notice of such tien is also filed in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is located.

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(3) Required Reliting Period,—In the case of any notice of lien, the term "required relaing period" means—
(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the

(A) The one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the lax, and

(B) the one-year period ending with the experience of 6 years after the close of the preceding required refiting period for such notice of lien.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Roleaso Ol, Lipn.—Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may presented, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of refease of any ten imposed with respect to any unternal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which—

(1) Dability Satisfied or Unenforceable —The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed -together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has been fully satisfied or has been fully unenforceable.

become lightly uneriforceable, or

(2) Bond Accepted —There is farmalised to the Secretary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed. Together with all interest in respect thereof, within the time prescribed by law (including any extension of such time), and that is in accordance with such requirements relating to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and surelies thereon, as may be specified by such regulations.

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and disclosure of returns and return information.

(k) Disclosure of Cerfain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes.—

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding then —If a notice of tien has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property
