Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in layor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the ben imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such hability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of tapse of time

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

- (a) Purchasers, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors. And Judgment Lien Creditors. - The ken imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest. mechanic's lienor, or judoment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary
- (b) Protection For Certain Interests Even Though Notice Filed. - Even though notice of a lien imposed by sec tion 6321 has been filed, such tien shall not be valid-

(3) Required Refiling Period,—In the case of any notice of fien, the term "required refiling period" means-

(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and

(B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the preceding required refiling period for such notice of tien.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien.—Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable —The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has

become legally unenforceable, or

(2) Bond Accepted -There is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, within the time prescribed by law (including any extension of such time), and that is in accorcance with such requirements relating to terms, conditions. and form of the bond and sureties thereon, as may be specified by such regulations
