

DEED OF RECONVEYANCE



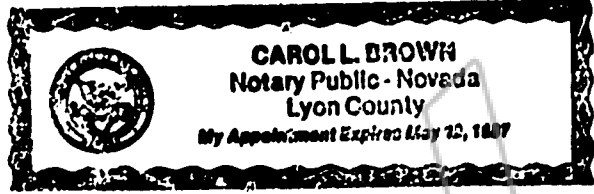
