On April 26, 1982, this Court issued a restraining order pursuant to its authority under 11 U.S.C. §105(a), restraining defendants herein from engaging in the following acts:

(1) That the defendants, and each of them, their employees and their agents be, and hereby are, pending hearing, restrained and enjoined from transferring or encumbering any real property or

1 7 livestock owned by them, in their possession or recorded in their
2 name.

3 (2) That defendants, and each of them, be, and hereby are
4 restrained and enjoined from transferring any real property or
5 money in any one transaction where more than \$1,000.00 in value
6 is involved.

7 As part of said Order, this Court issued an order to the defendants to show cause why a
8 preliminary injunction should not be issued as prayed for in the complaint. The
9 restraining order and the hearing on the order to show cause was continued by the Court
10 until May 24, 1982, at which time the first of four hearings on this matter was held.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, in accordance with the Findings of Fact and Conclusions
12 of Law filed herein,

13 IT IS ORDERED that unless the written consent of this Court on a showing of
14 good cause is first obtained, upon a noticed hearing,

15 (1) The defendants, and each of them, their employees and their
16 agents be, and hereby are, pending a full hearing of this claim for
17 relief on the merits, restrained and enjoined from transferring or
18 encumbering any real property or livestock owned by them, in
19 their possession or recorded in their name.

20 (2) The defendants, and each of them, be, and hereby are
21 restrained and enjoined from transferring any real property or
22 personal property in any one transaction where more than
23 \$1,000.00 in value is involved.

24 This preliminary injunction is granted without condition that a bond be filed
25 by plaintiff in view of the plaintiff's status as a Chapter 11 Trustee and the Court's
26 determination that no economic or other injury would result to any defendant or to the
27 public generally in consequence of the issuance of this Order.
