IT IS ORDERED ADJUDGED AND DECREED:

- 1. That all of the allegations set forth in the Complaint are true and correct.
- 2. That defendant is the natural father and Patricia Church is the mother of Dorey Ann Levi, born January 20, 1975.
- 3. That defendant pay for the support of his minor child, the sum of \$253.00 per month, commencing December 1, 1983, and to continue paying said amount on the first day of each and every month thereafter until further order of the Court.
- 4. That the defendant pay forthwith the sum of \$7,696.00 as and for reimbursement to the County of El Dorado for public assistance provided for Dorey Ann Lévi from May, 1981, through November, 1983.
- 5. That defendant shall make said payments for child support payable to Patricia Church, and reimbursement payable to the COUNTY OF EL DORADO, and send both to the Office of the District Attorney, Family Support Department, at 515 Main Street, Placerville, California 95667.
- 6. That defendant provide reasonable medical insurance coverage for the minor plaintiff and to provide the Office of the District Attorney, Family Support Department with evidence of such coverage.
- 7. That if defendant becomes unemployed, the County will intercept a portion of his unemployment benefit insurance as provided by law.
- 8. That if defendant becomes in arrears more than thirty (30) days, that a wage assignment be ordered as provided by law.

- 9. That the above judgment does not prohibit the County from putting defendant in State and Federal tax intercept program.
- 10. That defendant shall advise the District Attorney,
 Family Support Department, in writing, within ten days of every
 change of address or employment. Said advisement shall consist of
 the name and address of each new employer and each new residence.
- 11. That the District Attorney is ordered to enforce all child support orders arising out of this action.
- 12. That defendant pay the sum of \$150.00 as and for attorney's fees incurred in prosecuting this action, said sum to be paid forthwith to the El Dorado County Office of the District Attorney, Family Support Department, at 515 Main Street, Placerville, California 95667.
