MARITAL TERMINATION AGREEMENT

I. Parties

This agreement is made and entered into between PATRICIA SIDAS (hereinafter "Wife"), and ANDREW P. SIDAS (hereinafter "Husband").

II. Separation

By reason of irreconcilable differences existing between Husband and Wife, the parties acknowledge that they have ceased to live and Husband and Wife as of February 6, 1980, and have lived apart from that date to the date hereof.

III. Purpose of Agreement

The purpose of this agreement is to make a settlement of all the rights and obligations existing between the parties. The parties acknowledge there are two minor children of this marriage: Shana Sidas, born January 31, 1978; Randy Sidas, born January 31, 1979.

IV. Custody

Wife shall have legal and physical custody of the minor children, Shana Sidas and Randy Sidas. Husband shall have reasonable rights of visitation which shall not be limited to the South Lake Tahoe area.

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V. Child Support

Husband is ordered to pay to wife as and for child support the sum of \$175.00 per month per child, a total of \$350.00 per month, payable on the 15th day of each month, commencing July 15, 1984, and continuing as to each child their emancipation, death, or marriage, whichever shall occur first.

VI. Spousal Support

Neither husband nor wife presently request spousal support.

VII. Division of Community Property

Husband and Wife have no community property or debts to divide.

VIII. Confirming Separate Property

The following property is confirmed to Wife as her separate property: personal belongings.

The following property is confirmed to Husband as his separate property: 1975 Alfa Romeo automobile; 1975 truck; personal belongings.

IX. Right of Inheritance

Each party waives and renounces any and all right to inherit the estate of the other or the other's debts, or to receive any property of the other under any will executed before the effective date of this Agreement, or to claim any family allowance or probate homestead from the other's estate, or to act as executor or other personal representative under the will of the other executed before the effective date of this Agreement.

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Notwithstanding the provisions of this Agreement, either party may transfer, convey, devise or bequeath any property to the other, or act as such executor if so nominated subsequent to the date of this Agreement.

X. Partial Invalidity

To the extent that part of this agreement is held to be invalid, the other parts shall be considered severable and the partial invalidity shall not invalidate the remaining portions of the Agreement.

XI. Provision That Spouse Has Refused Legal Representation

This agreement has been prepared by Stephen Rapkin, attorney for Wife. Husband was not represented by an attorney during the negotiation of this agreement. Rapkin informed Husband that he was only representing Wife, that he had the right to an attorney, and that his rights would be better protected if he obtained an attorney. Husband acknowledges that he has read this agreement carefully and thoroughly, and fully understands each of its provisions and therefore signs it freely and voluntarily.

XII. Receipt of Copy

Each party hereby acknowledges receipt of this agreement. Any executed copy of this agreement is deemed to be an original for all purposes, and is a duplicate original.
