A mechanic's lien must be recorded within 90 days after the completion of the work of improvement as a whole unless the owner records a notice of completion. If a notice of completion. you have any question as to procedure, see your attorney.

These are the basic time periods. For an explanation of the variations on these time periods, and a full explanation of the Mechanic's Lien Law, see Chapter 9 of California Construction Law Manual (Building Industry Publishing general contractor or specialty contractor who contracted directly with the owner; in which case the mechanic's lien must be recorded within 60 days after the notice of completion was recorded.
