## Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any fax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount fincluding any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable negative together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal belonging to such person

### Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed for a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time

# Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests. Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. - The lien imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary

# in Place For Filing Notice: Form. -

(1) Place For Filing . The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed -

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated, and

(ii) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated.

(B). With Clerk Of District Court - In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A) or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia -In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia if the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of Columbia

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated.

(A) Real Property - In the case of real property at its physical location or

(B) Personal Property - In the case of personal property whether tangible or intangible at the residence of the taxpayer at the time the notice of lien is filed

For purposes of paragraph (2) (B) the residence of a corporation or partnership shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal executive office of the business is located and the residence of a taxpayer whose residence is without the United States shall be deemed to be in the District of Columbia

(3) Form - The form and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary Such notice shall be valid notwithstanding any other provision of law regarding the form or content of a notice of tren

- (g) Refiling Of Notice. For purposes of this
- (1) General Rule. Unless notice of lien is refiled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refiling pariod, such notice of hen shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filedlin accordance with subsection (fil after the expiration of such refiling period
- Place For Filing. A notice of tien refiled during the required refiling period shall be effective only (A) if

(i) such notice of lien is refiled in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and

(ii) in the case of real property, the fact of refiling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4) and

(B) in any case in which 90 days or more prior to the date of a refiling of notice of lien under subparagraph (A), the Secretary received written information in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary's concerning a change in the taxpayer's residence if a notice of such lien is also filed in accordance with subsection (file the State in which such residence is incated

(3) Required Refilling Period. — In the case of any notice of lien, the term required refiling period means. (A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the fax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the preceding required refiling period for such notice of Iren

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

ray Release Of Lien. - Separt to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shap issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue fair not later than 30 days after the day.

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable. The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed together with a 3 interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has

become legally unenforceable, or

(2) Bond Accepted - There is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed together with all interest in respect thereof, within the time prescribed by law lincluding any extension of such time), and that is in accordance with such requirements relating to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and sureties thereon, as may be specified by such regulations.
