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

The above-entitled action having this day come on regularly to be heard before the above-entitled Court, the undersigned District Judge presiding, upon the verified Complaint of the Plaintiff, the Plaintiff appearing in person and by his attorney, RONALD F. CAULEY, ESQ., and the Defendant not filing an Answer to the Complaint within the statutory time after service by publication and a Default being entered herein, that said cause be tried as a Default matter, and after hearing all the allegations and proofs of the Plaintiff, and all of the records and files in this case being admitted into evidence, and being fully advised in the premises, the Court now makes its FINDINGS OF FACT and CONCLUSIONS OF LAW as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. That the Plaintiff is a resident of the State of Nevada and for a period of six (6) weeks before commencement of this action has resided and been physically present and domiciled in the State of Nevada, and now resides and is

Plaintiff has had, and still has, the intent to make the State

of Nevada his home, residence and domicile for an indefinite

period of time.

- 2. That Plaintiff and Defendant were intermarried on or about the 19th day of August, 1980, and have been, and still are, WIFE and HUSBAND.
 - 3. That there are no children the issue of this marriage.
- 4. That there are the following community assets and separate property assets and obligation of the parties hereto:
- (a) The residence at 851 Amador Circle, Carson City, Nevada
 - (b) The 1964 Volkswagen Bug
 - (c) The 1981 Harley Davidson motorcycle
 - (d) All furniture, appliances and household items
 - (e) The stereo system
 - (f) The Union 76 Charge Card
 - 5. That the parties have become incompatible in marriage.

 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

As CONCLUSIONS OF LAW from the foregoing facts, the Court finds:

- 1. That the Plaintiff is a bona fide resident of the State of Nevada.
- 2. That the Court has jurisdiction over the Plaintiff and the subject matter of this action.
- 3. That the Plaintiff is entitled to a JUDGMENT and DECREE OF DIVORCE herein, absolutely and forever dissolving the bonds of matrimony now and heretofore existing between Plaintiff and Defendant, releasing them, and each of them, from all of the obligations thereof and restoring them, and each of them, to the status of a single person.
 - 4. That there are certain community assets and

obligations of the parties hereto within the jurisdiction of this Court and which are distributed herein in a fair and equitable manner.

LET JUDGMENT BE ENTERED ACCORDINGLY

DECREE OF DIVORCE

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that Plaintiff be, and he hereby is, awarded an absolute DECREE OF DIVORCE from Defendant upon the ground of incompatibility; that the marriage heretofore and now existing between Plaintiff and Defendant be, and the same hereby is, dissolved and declared forever at an end; that the Plaintiff and Defendant be, and each hereby is, restored to the status of an unmarried person.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the Plaintiff receive the following as his sole and separate property and obligation:

- The residence at 851 Amador Circle, Carson City, Nevada
- The 1964 Volkswagen Bug b)
- The 1981 Harley Davidson motorcycle c)
- All furniture, appliances and household items d)
- The Union 76 Charge Card

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the Defendant receive the stereo system.
