Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount fincluding any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal belonging to such person

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law the lien imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed for a judgment against the taxpaver arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. — The lien imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary

m Place For Filing Notice; Form. -

(1) Place For Filing . The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State for the county or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated, and

(iii) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State in which the property subject to the lien is situated

(B) With Clerk Of District Court - in the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A) or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia of the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of Columbia

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4) property shall be deemed to be situated

(A) Real Property In the case of real property at its physical location or

(B) Personal Property - In the case of personal property. whether tangible or intangible at the residence of the taxpayer at the time the notice of lien is filed.

For purposes of paragraph (2) (B) the residence of a corporation or partnership shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal executive office of the business is located, and the residence of a taxpayer whose residence is without the United States shall be deemed to be in the District of Columbia.

The form and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid notwithstanding any other provision of law regarding the form or content of a notice of tien

(3) Required Refiling Period. - In the case of any notice of fien, the term "required retiting" period "means-(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years. after the close of the preceding required refiling period for such notice of hen

tal Release Of Lien. - Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of rolease of any lien imposed. Aith respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which,

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable the Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof has been felly satisfied or has become legally unenforceable or

(2) Bond Accepted - There is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof within the time prescribed by law including any extension of such time), and that is in accordance with such requirements relating to terms conditions, and form of the bood and sureties thereon, as may be specified by such regulations.
