As additional security, Trustor hereby gives to and confers upon Beneficiary the right, power and authority during the continuance of these trusts, to collect the rents, issues and profits of said property, reserving unto Trustor the right, prior to any default by Trustor in payment of any indebtedness secured hereby or in performance of any agreement hereunder, to collect and retain such rents, issues and profits as they become due and payable. Upon any such default, Beneficiary may at any time without notice, either in person, by agent or by a receiver to be appointed by a court, and without regard to the adequacy of any security for the indebtedness hereby secured, enter upon and take possession of said property or any part thereof, in his own name sue for or otherwise collect such rents, issues and profits, including those past due and unpaid, and apply the same less costs and expenses of operation and collection, including reasonable attorney's fees, upon any indebtedness secured hereby, and in such order as Beneficiary may determine. The entering upon and taking possession of said property, the collection of such rents, issues and profits and the application thereof as aforesaid	
validate any act done pursuant to such notice. 9.Trustee is hereby authorized and instructed to release, by deed of partial reconveyance, either the property described in Exhibit "A" hereto or the property described in Exhibit "B" hereto, at the election of Trustor, from the encumbrance of this Deed of Trust upon payment by Trustor to Beneficiary of the sum of seventy-five percent (75%) of the principal sum due under the terms of the promissory note which this Deed of Trust secures when accompanied by payment of interest on the amount paid to the date of payment and provided that Trustor is not otherwise in default of his obligations set forth in this Deed of Trust. 10.
