STIPULATION AND ORDER FOR  
REIMBURSEMENT OF PUBLIC  
ASSISTANCE

18 IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED by and between the  
19 County of El Dorado, and Brenda Presavento, aka Brenda Hayden,  
20 the plaintiff and defendant, respectively in this action, that:

21 Brenda Hayden is the mother of Thomas Kirsch, born  
22 December 28, 1967.

23 During the time from November 19, 1984, through August  
24 23, 1985 said dependent was, in fact, supported by the County of  
25 El Dorado Welfare Department pursuant to Section 11350 of the  
26 Welfare and Institutions Code.

1 IT IS FURTHER STIPULATED AND AGREED that a judgment be  
2 entered against the defendant, Brenda Hayden, and in favor of the  
3 plaintiff, the County of El Dorado for welfare expended in the  
4 amount of \$1,230.00 to be paid in the monthly amount of \$60.00,  
5 commencing October 1, 1986. Said payments are to be made on the  
6 1st day of each and every month thereafter until said amount of  
7 \$1,230.00 is fully paid. If defendant defaults in any monthly  
8 payments, the full amount is due and payable upon demand.

9 IF IS FURTHER STIPULATED AND AGREED if the defendant  
10 becomes in arrears more than 30 days, that a wage assignment be  
11 ordered as provided by law.

12 IT IS FURTHER STIPULATED AND AGREED that the above  
13 mentioned reimbursement payments are to be made payable to the  
14 County of El Dorado and sent to the Office of the District  
15 Attorney, Family Support Division, at 7563 Green Valley Road,  
16 Placerville, CA 95667.

17 Defendant understands that if he becomes unemployed the  
18 County will intercept a portion of his unemployment benefit  
19 insurance as provided by law.

20 Defendant understands the above agreement does not  
21 prohibit the County from putting him in State and Federal tax  
22 intercept program.

23 That the defendant shall notify and provide the Office  
24 of the District Attorney, in writing, within ten days of any

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changes, and/or new names and addresses of residences and employers or if unemployed.
