Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to ay the same after demand, the amount (including any interst, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, ogether with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) hall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property nd rights to property, whether real or personal, balonging

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by lew, the lien nposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment smade and shall continue until the liability for the amount so ssessed (or a judgement against the taxpayer arising out of uch liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason

## Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's Holders Of Security Inerests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgement len Creditors. - The lien imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security nearest, mechanic's lienor, or judgement lien creditor until tolice thereof which ments the requirements of subsection (I) iss been filed by the Secretary.

## (I) Place For Filing Notice; Form.-

(1) Place For Filling. The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed.

(A) Under State Laws.

(i) Real Property. In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lion is situated; and (ii) Personal Property. In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is slivated; or

(B) With Clark OI District Court - In the office of the clark of
the United States district court for the judicial district in which
the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has
subparagraph (A), or
(C) With Recorder OI Deeds Of The District Of Columbia - In
the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if

For purposes of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation

For purposes of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or partnership shell be deemed to be the place at which the principal executive office of the business is located, and the residence of a texpayer whose residence is without the United States shell be deemed to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - The form and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shell be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shell be valid notwithstanding any other provision of law regarding the form or content of a notice of line.

(1) Goneral Rule. - Unless notice of tien is refiled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required reliling period, such notice of lien shall be treated as illed on the date on which it is liled (in accordance with subsection (i)) after the expiration of such religing period.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lion OrDischargo Of Property

(a) Release Of Lien. - Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prascribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of only lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary Indistrict the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become legally unenforceable; or
(2) Bond Accepted - There is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by him abond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, within the time prescribed by law (including any extension of such time), and that is in accordance with such requirements relating to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and sureties thereon, as may be specified by such regulations.
