Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition therato, shall be a lien in layor of the United States upon all property and rights to properly, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unloss another data is specifically fixed by law, the flon imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed for a judgement against the texpayor arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's Holders Of Security in terests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgement Lien Creditors. - The lien imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgement lien creditor unity notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (i) has been filed by the Secretary.

(B) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxpayer at the time the notice of lien is filled.

Forpurposes of paragraph (2) (II), the residence of a corporation or partnership shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal executive office of the business is located, and the residence of a taxpayer whose residence is without the United States shall be deemed to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - The form and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid notwithstanding any other provision of law regarding the form or content of a notice of lien.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Discharge Of **Property**

(a) Reléase Of Lien. -Sublect to such regulations as the Secretary may proscribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on

(2) Bond Accopted -Thora is lurnished to the Secretary and accepted intensistential and the secretary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, logether with all interest in respect thereof, within the time proscribed by faw (including any extension of such time), and that is in accordance with such requirements relating to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and surelies thereon, as may be specified by such regulations.

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lien. - If a notice of lien has been liled pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any parson who lurnishes salislactory written evidence that he has right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
