Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in layor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the flen imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgement against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgement Lien Creditors. - The Ilen Imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgement lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (I) has been filled by the Secretary.

(n Place For Filling Notice; Form.

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed (A) Under State Laws
(i) Real Property - in the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the filen is situated; and
(ii) Personal Property - in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; or

(B) With Clerk OI District Court - In the office of the clerk of
the United States district court for the judicial district in which
the property subject to tien is situated, whenever the State has
subparagraph (A), or
(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia - In

the alice of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia. In the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of Columbia.

(2) Silus OI Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be siluated -

(A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its

(3) Form - The form and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid notwithstanding any other provision of law regarding the form or content of a notice of lien.

(g) Refiling Of Notice. - For purchase of this

(1) General Rule. - Unless notice of lien is railled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required railling period, such notice of lien shall be treated as filled on the date on which it is filled (in accordance with subsection (i)) after expiration of such railling pariod.

(2) Place For Filling. - A notice of tien relied during the required reliling period shall be effective only - (A) ii -

(A) II (I) such notice of lien is reflied in the office in which the
prior notice of lien was filed, and

(3) Required Refilling Period. - In the case of any notice of lian, the term "required relilling period" means.
(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 5 years after the date of the assessment of the lax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 5 years after the close of the preceding required relilling period for such notice of lian.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Discharge Of Property

(a) Release Of Lien. - Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any flen imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on

which

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable. The Secretary linds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become legally unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted. There is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by hime bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, within the time prescribed by law (including any extension of such time), and that is in accordance with such requirements relating to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and sureties thereon, as may be specified by such regulations.

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and closure of Returns and Return In-

of Certain Returns and (k) Disclosure Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes. -

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lien. - if a notice of lienhas been filled pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
