ORDER/JUDGMENT

JOHN (JONATHAN) W. TURNER,

Defendant.

A stipulation by and between the parties having been filed with this Court in relation to the above-entitled matter, the court having reviewed said stipulation and all other pleadings and documents on file with the clerk of this Court, the parties having agreed to the entry of this order and judgment by their stipulation, and good cause appearing;

This Court finds, concludes, and orders as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- Defendant is the father of JONATHAN W. TURNER, JR., born March 30, 1977.
- On or about January 20, 1983, the Family Court of Hamilton County, New York, entered an order requiring the 164831 BOOK 1087 PAGE 2904

defendant to pay the sum of \$35.00 per week for the support of his minor son JONATHAN W. TURNER, JR., said payments to be made through the Hamilton County Support Collection Unit, Lake Pleasant, New York. This order also required the defendant to purchase a \$50.00 savings bond each month for his minor son, JONATHAN W. TURNER, JR., said bonds to be turned over to his minor son upon his attainment of the age of eighteen years. support order was terminated by later order entered by the Family Court of Hamilton County, New York, in or around January, 1984.

- The Hamilton County Department of Social Services, 3. Lake Pleasant, New York, paid out public assistance monies as and for the support of defendant's minor son, JONATHAN W. TURNER, JR., during the period January 16, 1986, through August 11, 1987, in the amount of \$2,719.50.
- Defendant agrees to pay \$208.00 per month to the Hamilton County Department of Social Services. Defendant further agrees that each month \$158.00 of the \$208.00 monthly amount be given to Mary Turner for the current support of defendant's minor Defendant also agrees that the son, JONATHAN W. TURNER, JR. remaining \$50.00 of each \$208.00 monthly payment be taken by the Hamilton County Department of Social Services and applied as reimbursement for the \$2,719.50 which it paid out as public assistance.
- Defendant desires that this court enter an order requiring that the \$208.00 monthly payment for support be 164831

withheld from his wages and commissions. Defendant's request is made freely and voluntarily.

6. Every finding of fact hereinabove which is held upon review to be a conclusion of law is hereby adopted as such.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. This Court has jurisdiction of the subject matter and the defendant.
- 2. Under Nevada law, defendant's payments for support may be withheld from his wages and commissions by his voluntary request.
- 3. Defendant owes a duty of support to his minor son JONATHAN W. TURNER, JR.
- 4. Defendant must reimburse Hamilton County Department of Social Services, Lake Pleasant, New York, for the \$2,719.50 paid out as public assistance.
- 5. Every conclusion of law here and above which upon review is held to be a finding of fact is hereby adopted as such.

ORDER AND JUDGMENT

- 1. Plaintiff shall have and recover judgment in the amount of \$2,719.50, which sum represents public assistance provided for the support of defendant's minor child, JONATHAN W. TURNER, JR., during the period January 16, 1986, through August 11, 1987.
- 2. Defendant shall pay \$50.00 per month as reimbursement for the \$2,719.50 paid out as public assistance by the Hamilton County Department of Social Services, Lake Pleasant, New York.

3. Defendant shall pay \$158.00 per month for the current support of his minor child, JONATHAN W. TURNER, JR.

4. That the \$50.00 per month payment as reimbursement for public assistance provided and the \$158.00 per month payment for current support shall be combined into a single monthly payment of \$208.00.

6. Said monthly payments shall be made by wage withholding. Said monthly payments are to commence on October 10, 1987, and are to continue on the 10th day of each month thereafter until JONATHAN W. TURNER, JR., emancipates or until further order of this Court. Said monthly payments by wage withholding shall be forwarded to the DOUGLAS COUNTY CLERK, P.O. Box 218, Minden, Nevada 89423. The Douglas County Clerk shall transmit said payments to the HAMILTON COUNTY SUPPORT COLLECTION UNIT, Lake Pleasant, New York 12108.
