A stipulation by and between the parties having been filed with this Court in relation to the above-entitled matter, the court having reviewed said stipulation and all other pleadings and documents on file with the clerk of this Court, the parties having agreed to the entry of this order and judgment by their stipulation, and good cause appearing;

This Court finds, concludes, and orders as follows:

## FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Defendant is the father of MARTIN CHRISTOPHER SOLGAT, born December 25, 1970.

- 2. Defendant's support obligation for MARTIN
  CHRISTOPEHR SOLGAT, born December 25, 1970, is \$100.00 per month
  until said minor child reaches the age of 18 years, marries or is
  sooner self-supporting, pursuant to a decree of divorce on file
  in King County, Washington, dated September 27, 1972.
- 3. Child support arrears for defendant's minor child MARTIN CHRISTOPHER SOLGAT accrued during the period June, 1972, through December 1986, in the amount of \$2,700.00.
- 4. Defendant's child support obligation during the period January, 1987, through November, 1987, computed at the rate of \$100.00 per month, is \$1,100.00, for his minor child MARTIN CHRISTOPHER SOLGAT, born December 25, 1970.
- 5. During the period January, 1987, through November, 1987, defendant paid the sum of \$2,270.00, as child support for his minor child MARTIN CHRISTOPHER SOLGAT, born December 25, 1970.
- 6. Defendant is in arrears in his child support obligation in the sum of \$1,530.00, computed as follows:

  Arrearages of \$2,700.00 through December, 1986, plus \$1,100.00 owed as child support during the period January through November, 1987, equals \$3,800.00, minus \$2,270.00 paid by defendant in 1987, for a child support arrearage sum of \$1,530.00, through November, 1987.

- 7. Defendant agrees to pay \$300.00 on December 5, 1987, \$100.00 to be applied as ongoing support, and \$200.00 to be applied as payment on child support arrears.
- 8. Defendant understands that an income or wage withholding may be sought by the plaintiff if the defendant becomes thirty days or more delinquent in making his child support payments.
- 9. Every finding of fact hereinabove which is held upon review to be a conclusion of law is hereby adopted as such.

## CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. This Court has jurisdiction of the subject matter and the defendant.
- 2. Defendant owes a duty of support to his minor child MARTIN CHRISTOPHER SOLGAT, born December 25, 1970.
- 3. Every conclusion of law hereinabove which upon review is held to be a finding of fact is hereby adopted as such.

## ORDER AND JUDGMENT

1. Defendant shall pay \$100.00 per month for the support of his minor child MARTIN CHRISTOPHER SOLGAT, born December 25, 1970. The initial payment shall be due on December 5, 1987, and subsequent payments shall be due on the 5th day of each month thereafter until the minor child emancipates or further order of the court.

- 2. Judgment shall be entered in favor of plaintiff for arrearages for the period June, 1972, through November 18, 1987, in the amount of \$1,530.00.
- 3. Defendant shall pay the sum of \$75.00 per month to be applied as payment on his \$1,530.00 arrearage, the initial payment to be due on December 5, 1987, and subsequent payments shall be due on the 5th day of each month thereafter until \$1,530.00 arrearage has been paid in full. Said \$75.00 per month payment on arrears may be combined with defendant's \$100.00 per month ongoing child support payment, for a total monthly sum of \$175.00; however, defendant shall pay \$300.00 on December 5, 1987, \$100.00 to be applied as ongoing child support, and \$200.00 to be applied as payment on child support arrears.
- 4. All child support payments and reimbursement payments shall be made by defendant in the form of a cashier's check, certified check, or money order, or in cash. If the payment is in the form of cash it must be delivered to the Douglas County Clerk at her office in Minden, Nevada. If the payment is in the form of a cashier's check, certified check, or money order, Defendant understands that it must be made payable to the DOUGLAS COUNTY CLERK and be either mailed to the Douglas County Clerk at Post Office Box 218, Minden, Nevada 89423, or delivered to said County Clerk at her office in Minden, Nevada. The Douglas County Clerk shall transmit said payments to OFFICE

OF SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT, Case No. D 95443, P.O. Box C-11008, Seattle, WA 98111.

4. An income or wage withholding may be sought by the plaintiff if the defendant becomes thirty days or more delinquent in making his child support payments.
