Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, ast, additional amount, intrinsic to talk, or assessment property logister with any costs that may accrue in addition thereigh shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another data is specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the Rability for the amount so assessed for a judgement against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied by becomes unanforcable by reason of lapse of time

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgement Lion Creditors. - The Hen Imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security Interest, mechanic's flenor, or judgement flen craditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (I) has been filed by the Secretary.

(i) Place For Filing Notice; Form.-

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed - (A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State for the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in

property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State for the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated;

(B) With Clark Of District Court - In the office of the clark of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia - In the office of the Recorder of Deads of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the I-en is situated in the District of Columbia

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated .

(A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its physical location, or

(B) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, at the residence of the tarpayer at the time the notice of fien is filed.

For purposes of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or partnership shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal executive office of the business is located, and the residence of a tempeyer whose residence is without the United

States shall be deemed to be in the District of Columbia.

(2) Form - The form and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shell be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shell be welld notwithstanding any other provision of law regarding the form or centent of a notice of tien
