## Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgement against the taxpayer arising out of h t'ability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason Stress of time.

## Corp. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

Telefisher's Holders Of Security In- Inchanic's Lienors, And Judgement States. - The lien imposed by section 6321 shall \* \*\* \*qainst any purchaser, holder of a security with high lienor, or judgement flen creditor until a stablish meets the requirements of subsection (I) "er! by the Secretary.

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated -

(B) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxpayer at the time the notice of lien is illed.

For purposes of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or partnership shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal executive office of the business is located, and the

residence of a taxpayer whose residence is without the United States shall be deemed to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form • The form and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid notwithstanding any other provision of law regarding the form or content of a notice of iten.

(g) Refiling Of Notice. - For purchase of this

(1) General Rule. - Unless notice of lien is relified in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the regulred ratiling parlod, such notice of lien shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (i)) after the expiration of such reliling period.

(a) Release Of Lien. - Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall Issue a certificate of release of any iten imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on
