- 2. There is a court order requiring defendant to pay child support.
- 3. Said minor children are receiving public assistance from Yolo County and the necessary monthly expense for the support of said children is \$159.00 per child per month.
- 4. As of December, 1987, there is a balance due and owing in the sum of \$4,438.67.
- 5. That the defendant was personally served in Douglas County, Nevada, with a copy of the summons and complaint in the above-entitled matter on March 15, 1988.
- 6. That defendant failed to answer or otherwise defend against plaintiff's complaint. A default was entered by the Court Clerk against defendant on April 18, 1988.
- 7. That any finding of fact hereinabove stated which upon review is held to be a conclusion of law is hereby adopted as such.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- That this Court has jurisdiction both of the subject matter and the defendant.
- 2. That defendant owes a duty of support to his minor children EUGENE SOULIER, IV, born September 18, 1983, and LINDSEY SOULIER, born September 19, 1987.

3. Any conclusion of law above-stated which is held upon review to be a finding of fact is hereby adopted as such.

ORDER

- That defendant shall pay the sum of \$159.00 per 1. child per month as and for the support of his minor children EUGENE SOULIER, IV, born September 18, 1983, and LINDSEY SOULIER, born September 19, 1987. The first \$318.00 payment is to be made on May 23, 1988, and continuing of the 23rd day of each month thereafter until said minor children are emancipated or until further order of this Court.
- That plaintiff shall have and recover as a judgment against the defendant the amount of \$4,438.67, as and for child support arrears as of December, 1987.
- Over and above current or ongoing child support, defendant shall pay the additional monthly sum of \$25.00, to be applied as payment on child support arrears. That the initial payment shall be due on May 23, 1988, and subsequent payments shall be due on the 23rd day of each month thereafter until the \$4,438.67 arrearage is retired or satisfied or further order of this Court.
- That defendant's monthly current or ongoing child support payment and monthly payment on child support arrears shall be combined into a single monthly payment of \$343.00.

5. That said monthly payments shall be made by defendant either in the form of a cashier's check, certified check, or money order or in cash. If the payment is in the form of cash, it must be delivered to the Douglas County Clerk at her office in Minden, Nevada. If the payment is in the form of a cashier's check, certified check, or money order, it must be made payable to the DOUGLAS COUNTY CLERK and be either mailed to the Douglas County Clerk at Post Office Box 218, Minden, Nevada 89423, or delivered to said County Clerk at her office in Minden, Nevada. The Douglas County Clerk shall transmit said payments to the DISTRICT ATTORNEY, FAMILY SUPPORT DIVISION, Case NO. 86-0243, P.O. Box 1385, woodland, California 95695.

6. Defendant is hereby advised that if his ongoing child support payments or payments toward child support arrears become 30 days delinquent a wage withholding could be initiated pursuant to NRS Chapter 31A.
