The above-entitled matter having come before this Court on an Application for Default Judgment on the 9th day of May, 1988, present in Court Robert F. Balkenbush, Deputy District Attorney, Douglas County, Nevada, representing the plaintiff, and defendant not appearing, nor legal counsel on his behalf,

The Court finds, concludes and orders as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. That the defendant and LISA COLEEN SOULIER are the parents of the following minor children, said children reside in the County of Yolo, and said parents were husband and wife.

EUGENE SOULIER, IV, born September 18, 1983

LINDSEY SOULIER, born September 19, 1987

2 2. There is a court order requiring defendant to pay  
3 child support.

4 3. Said minor children are receiving public  
5 assistance from Yolo County and the necessary monthly expense for  
6 the support of said children is \$159.00 per child per month.

7  
8 4. As of December, 1987, there is a balance due and  
9 owing in the sum of \$4,438.67.

10 5. That the defendant was personally served in  
11 Douglas County, Nevada, with a copy of the summons and complaint  
12 in the above-entitled matter on March 15, 1988.

13  
14 6. That defendant failed to answer or otherwise defend  
15 against plaintiff's complaint. A default was entered by the  
16 Court Clerk against defendant on April 18, 1988.

17 7. That any finding of fact hereinabove stated which  
18 upon review is held to be a conclusion of law is hereby adopted  
19 as such.

20  
21 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

22 1. That this Court has jurisdiction both of the  
23 subject matter and the defendant.

24 2. That defendant owes a duty of support to his minor  
25 children EUGENE SOULIER, IV, born September 18, 1983, and LINDSEY  
26 SOULIER, born September 19, 1987.

1 5. That said monthly payments shall be made by  
2 defendant either in the form of a cashier's check, certified  
3 check, or money order or in cash. If the payment is in the form  
4 of cash, it must be delivered to the Douglas County Clerk at her  
5 office in Minden, Nevada. If the payment is in the form of a  
6 cashier's check, certified check, or money order, it must be made  
7 payable to the DOUGLAS COUNTY CLERK and be either mailed to the  
8 Douglas County Clerk at Post Office Box 218, Minden, Nevada  
9 89423, or delivered to said County Clerk at her office in Minden,  
10 Nevada. The Douglas County Clerk shall transmit said payments to  
11 the DISTRICT ATTORNEY, FAMILY SUPPORT DIVISION, Case NO. 86-0243,  
12 P.O. Box 1385, woodland, California 95695.

14 6. Defendant is hereby advised that if his ongoing  
15 child support payments or payments toward child support arrears  
16 become 30 days delinquent a wage withholding could be initiated  
17 pursuant to NRS Chapter 31A.
