16 Upon application from Harold Kuehn, Douglas County  
17 Deputy District Attorney, at the request of Jeffrey Michael  
18 McBryde, this cause came on for hearing in the above-entitled  
19 Court on the 9th day of May, 1988, with the following present:  
20 Deputy District Attorney Robert F. Balkenbush, counsel for  
21 plaintiff, and Defendant Jeffrey Michael McBryde appearing  
22 without counsel,

23 After considering all the evidence, the Court finds and  
24 concludes that:

- 25 1. Defendant owes a duty of support to his minor  
26 children JENNIFER MC BRYDE, born May 5, 1976, and JULIE MC BRYDE,  
27 born November 13, 1979, who reside with plaintiff.

1           2. Defendant was ordered by the Superior Court of  
2 California, County of County of El Dorado, to pay \$50.00 per  
3 month per child as child support.

4  
5           3. The court had personal jurisdiction over the  
6 defendant when it issued the support order.

7           4. This Court finds that the defendant is in arrears  
8 in the sum of \$5,650.00 for the period January, 1983, to May 9,  
9 1988.

10  
11           5. Defendant is at least 30 days delinquent in his  
12 aforesaid child support obligation.

13           6. Defendant requested an opportunity to pay his  
14 current or ongoing monthly \$100.00 child support obligation and  
15 \$50.00 per month toward the child support arrearage of \$5,650.00  
16 without wage withholding.

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18           Based upon the foregoing findings and conclusions, IT  
19 IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

20           1. Plaintiff shall have and recover judgment in the  
21 amount of \$5,650.00, which sum represents child support arrears  
22 through and including May 9, 1988.

23  
24           2. Defendant shall pay \$50.00 per month toward the  
25 \$5,650.00 child support arrearage. The first payment shall be  
26 due on May 10, 1988, Subsequent \$50.00 payments shall be due on  
27 the 10th day of each month thereafter until the \$5,650.00 child

1 support arrearage is retired or satisfied or further order of  
2 this Court.

3 3. Defendant shall pay \$50.00 per month per child for  
4 the current or ongoing support of his minor children JENNIFER MC  
5 BRYDE, born May 5, 1976, and JULIE MC BRYDE, born November 13,  
6 1979. The first payment is to be made on May 10, 1988.  
7 Subsequent payments shall be due on the 10th day of each month  
8 thereafter until said minor children emancipate or further order  
9 of this Court.

10 4. That the \$50.00 per month payment toward child  
11 support arrears, and the \$100.00 per month payment for current or  
12 ongoing support shall be combined into a single monthly payment  
13 of \$150.00.

14 5. That said \$150.00 monthly payments shall be made by  
15 defendant either in the form of a cashier's check, certified  
16 check or money order or in cash. If the payment is in the form  
17 of cash, it must be delivered to the Douglas County Clerk at her  
18 office in Minden, Nevada. If the payment is in the form of a  
19 cashier's check, certified check or money order, it must be made  
20 payable to the DOUGLAS COUNTY CLERK and be either to the Douglas  
21 County Clerk at Post Office Box 218, Minden, Nevada 89423, or  
22 delivered to said County Clerk at her office in Minden, Nevada.  
23 The Douglas County Clerk shall transmit said payments to EL  
24 DORADO COUNTY FAMILY SUPPORT, Case No. 12483, 7563 Green Valley  
25 Road, Placerville, California 95667.

1 6. Defendant was advised in open Court and is also  
2 hereby advised that if his current or ongoing child support  
3 payments or payments toward child support arrears become 30 days  
4 delinquent, a wage withholding shall be initiated in accordance  
5 with NRS Chapter 31 A.  
6

7 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that defendant must advise the  
8 Douglas County District Attorney's Office in writing or by  
9 telephone within 10 days of every change in home address, mailing  
10 address, or employment.
