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## **Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code**

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any inter-est, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition therato) shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgement against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgement Lian Creditors. - The Ilen Imposed by section 8321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's ilenor, or judgement ilen creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (I) has been filled by the Secretary.

## (I) Place For Filling Notice: Form.-

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed (A) Under State Laws
(I) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and
(II) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; or

(B) With Clerk Of District Court - in the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the Judicial district in which

the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has subparagraph (A), or (C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia - In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of

situated -(A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its

(A) real Property - in the case or real property, at its physical location; or (B) Personal Property - in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxpayer at the time the notice of lien is filled.

For purposes of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or partnership shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal executive office of the business is located, and the residence of a tempayer whose residence is without the United States shall be deemed to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - The form and content of the notice

(3) Form - The form and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid notwithstanding any Secretary. Such notice shall be valid notwithstanding any other provision of law regarding the form or content of a notice of lien.

- (g) Refilling Of Notice. For purchase of this
- (1) General Rule. Unless notice of tien is relified in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refiling period, such notice of ilen shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filled (in accordance with subsection (I)) after e expiration of such reliling period.
- (2) Place For Filling. A notice of lien relied during the required refilling period shall be effective only -
  - (i) such notice of Ken is relited in the office in which the

    (ii) in the case of real property, the fact of refilling is
    entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by

- (3) Required Refiling Period. In the case any notice of lien, the term "required refilling period" means-(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the preceding required railling period for such notice of lien.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Discharge Of Property

(a) Release Of Lien. - Subject to me regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shorts use a cartificate of release of any life imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereol, has been fully satisfied or has become legally unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted - There is furnished to the Secretary and

accepted by hime bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, within the time prescribed by law (including and extension of such time), and that is in accordance with the requirements relating to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and sureties thereon, as may be specified by such regulations.

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return Information.

(k) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes. -
