(g) Refilling Of Notice. - For purchase of this section -

(1) General Rule. - Unless notice of lies is relified in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refilling period, such notice of tien shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filled (in accordance with subsection (i)) after the expiration of such retiling period.

(2) Place For Filing. - A notice of tien relied during the required reliling period shall be effective only -

(i) such notice of tien is reflied in the office in which the

prior notice of lien was filed, and
(ii) in the case of real property, the fact of refiling is
entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (1) (4), and

(B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a raliling of notice of ilen under subparagraph (A), the Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpayer's residence, if a notice of such lien is also filed in accordance with subsection (i) in the State in which such residence is located.

(3) Required Refiling Period. - In the case of any notice of lien, the term "required refilling period" means -(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the preceding required reliling period for such notice of lien.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Discharge **Property** Of.

(a) Release Of Lien. - Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall Issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become legally unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted - There is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by hime bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, within the time prescribed by law (including any extension of such time), and that is in accordance with such requirements relating to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and sureties thereon, as may be specified by such regulations.

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return Information.

(k) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes. -

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lien. - if a notice of lien has been lifed pursuant to section 6323(1), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
