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19 Creditor HARRY JUNG's Motion to Convert the debtors' case
20 from a case under Chapter 11 to a case under Chapter 7 came on for
21 hearing on August 1, 1988. The debtors appeared by and thru their
22 attorney, Lawrence Jacobsen of Cohen & Jacobsen. Moving Party
23 HARRY JUNG appeared by and through Sidney A. Luscutoff of
24 Birenbaum, Luscutoff & Lendormy. Due notice was given to creditors
25 and other parties in interest.

26 The debtors noted that they consented to a conversion of
27 their Chapter 11 bankruptcy case to a case under Chapter 7 of the
28 Bankruptcy Code and that they did not oppose Creditor JUNG's motion

1 for conversion.


2 Based upon the record and file in this case and upon the

11 appointed interim trustee of the estate of CHARLES LEE SMITH and
12 BARBARA JEAN SMITH, and that he shall serve under his general
13 trustee's bond.


