The above-entitled matter came on for hearing October 24, 1988, pursuant to Show Cause order entered September 21, 1988, present in court were Robert F. Balkenbush, Deputy District Attorney for Douglas County, Nevada, representing the plaintiff, and defendant appearing without counsel.

The Court finds, concludes and orders as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. That in an Order of Approval, filed May 27, 1982, the Eighth Judicial District Court of the State of Nevada in and for the County of Clark, defendant was ordered to reimburse plaintiff for public assistance paid for the support of his minor child RYAN ANTHONY SCALISE, born October 7, 1976, in the amount

of \$1,515.00 to be paid at the rate of TWENTY-FIVE (\$25.00) per month, commencing May 25, 1982.

- 2. Defendant was further ordered to advise District Attorney's Office, Family Support Division, in writing or by telephone, WITHIN TEN (10) DAYS OF EVERY change in home address or employment.
- 3. That defendant has made some payments and an outstanding balance of \$1,173.90 remains due and owing plaintiff.
- Any finding of fact above-stated which upon review is held to be a conclusion of law is hereby adopted as such.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. In this proceeding, this Court has jurisdiction of the defendant and the subject matter.
- Any conclusion of law above-stated which review is held to be a finding of fact is hereby adopted as such.

ORDER

- defendant shall pay \$25.00 1. That per month reimbursement of a \$1,173.90 debt for support. That the initial payment shall be due on November 1, 1988, and subsequent payments shall be due on the first day of each month thereafter until the \$1,173.90 debt for support is retired or further order of this Court.
- · 2 . That the monthly \$25.00 installments and the \$1,173.90 debt for support shall be made by payments on defendant either in the form of a cashier's check, certified check or money order or in cash. If the payment is in the form

of cash, it must be delivered to the Douglas County Clerk at her office in Minden, Nevada. If the payment is in the form of a cashier's check, certified check or money order, it must be made payable to the DOUGLAS COUNTY CLERK, and be either mailed to the Douglas County Clerk at P.O. Box 218, Minden, Nevada 89423, or delivered to said County Clerk at her office in Minden, Nevada. The Douglas County Clerk shall transmit said payments to the FAMILY SUPPORT DEPT., DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE, EL DORADO, COUNTY, Case No. R13448, 515 Main St. Placerville, CA 95667.

- 3. That defendant shall notify the Douglas County
 District Attorney's Office in writing or by telephone, within ten
 (10) days of every change in mailing address, home address and
 employment.
- 4. That failure to make a monthly \$25.00 payment shall result in that amount being withheld by wage withholding without further notice to the defendant.
