Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person Hable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount fincluding any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto; shall be a flen in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed try law, the Sen Imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment. is made and shall continue until the Eability for the amount a assessed for a judgement against the texpayer erising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's Holders Of Security Interes:s, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgement Lian Craditors. - The lien imposed by section \$321 shell not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, machanic's lienor, or judgement lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

(a) Release Of Lien. Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall Issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tex not later than 30 days after the day on which .

(I) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has

become legally unenforceable; or (2) Bond Accepted - There is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, within the time prescribed by law (including any extension of such time), and that is in accordance with such requirements relating to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and swelles thereon, as may be specified by such regulations.
