

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another data is specifically fixed by law, the lies imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgement against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgement Lien Creditors. - The lien imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's tienor, or judgement lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (I) has been filed by the Secretary.

(3) Form - The form and centent of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid notwithstanding any other provision of law regarding the form or content of a notice that

(g) Refiling Of Notice. - For purchase of this section -

(1) General Rule. - Unless notice of lien is reflied in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required reliling period, such notice of tien shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (i)) atter the expiration of such reliling period.

(2) Place For Filling. - A notice of tien railled during the required railling period shall be affective only -

(ii) in the case of real property, the fact of religion in entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by

(3) Required Refiling Period. - In the case of any notice of ilen, the term "required retiling period" means -(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the preceding required rafiling period for such notice of lien.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Discharge Of Property

(a) Release Of Lien. - Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on

(1) Liability Satistied or Unenforceable - The Secretary linds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has

become legally unenforceable; or (2) Bond Accepted - There is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by him abond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, within the time prescribed by law (including any extension of such time), and that is in accordance with such requirements relating to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and sureties thereon, as may be specified by such regulations.

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return Information.

(ii) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes. -

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lien. - if a notice of lien has been liled pursuant to section 6323(I), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such iron may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
