

## Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgement against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of large of time. of lapse of time.

## Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgement Lien Creditors. - The Iten Imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgement lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filled by the Secretary.

## (n) Place For Filling Notice; Form.-

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be illed (A) Under State Laws
(i) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and
(ii) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; or

(B) With Clerk Of District Court - In the office of the clerk of
the United States district court for the judicial district in which
the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has
subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District of Columbia - In
the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if
the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of
Columbia.

(2) Situa Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated -

situated.

(A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its physical location; or

(B) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxpayer at the time the notice of lien is filled.

For purposes of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or partnership shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal executive office of the business is located, and the residence of a taxpayer whose residence is without the United States shall be deemed to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - The form and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid notwithstanding any other provision of law regarding the form or content of a notice of lien.

1. Securities

(g) Refiling Of Notice. - For purchase of this

(1) General Rule. - Unless notice of lien is reflied in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required retilling period, such notice of ilen shall be treated as filled on the date on which it is filled (in accordance with subsection (i)) after the expiration of such retilling period.

(2) Place For Filling. - A notice of tien relied uring the required reliling period shall be effective only - (A) if -

(A) II(i) such notice of iten is relified in the office in which the prior notice of iten was filled, and
(ii) in the case of real property, the fact of refilling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (i) (4), and
(B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a reliting of notice of lien under subparagraph (A), the Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpayer's residence, if a notice of such lien is also filled in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is located.

(3) Required Refiling Period. - In the case of any notice of lien, the term "required reliting period" means(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration
of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and
(B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years
after the close of the preceding required reliting period for
such notice of lien.

(2) Bond Accepted - There is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by hime bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, within the time prescribed by law (including any extension of such time), and that is in accordance with such requirements relating to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and suraties thereon, as may be specified by such regulations.

(k) Disclosure of Certain Returns Return Information For Tax Administration

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lien. - if a notice of lien has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
