emancipates and \$13,242.00 arrearage is retired or  
satisfied or until further order of this Court.

1 12. X NOTICE: This is an income withholding order. Support  
2 payments in arrears by 30 days may be withheld from income  
3 without further order of any court or further application  
4 for services.
