Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the ilen imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgement against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgement Lign Creditors. - The lien imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's ilenor, or judgement lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

(I) Place For Filing Notice; Form.-

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be illed (A) Under State Laws
(i) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and
(ii) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; or

Or (I) With Clark Of District Court - In the office of the clark of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has subparagraph (A), or (C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia - In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of Columbia.

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated -

(A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its physical location; or (3) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxpayer at the time the notice of lien is filed.

For purposes of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or partnership shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal executive office of the business is located, and the residence of a texpayer whose residence is without the United States shall be deemed to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - The form and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid notwithstanding any other provision of law regarding the form or content of a notice of lien.

(g) Refilling Of Notice. - For purchase of this

(1) General Rule. - Unless notice of lien is reliied in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required reliiing period, such notice of lien shall be treated as filed on the which it is liled (in accordance with subsection (i)) after the expiration of such retiling period.

(2) Place For Filling. - A notice of lien rel uring the required refilling period shall be effective only -(A) if -

(A) if
(i) such notice of iten is refilled in the office in which the prior notice of iten was filled, and

(ii) in the case of real property, the fact of refilling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (i) (4), and

(B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a refilling of notice of iten under subparagraph (A), the Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpayer's residence, if a notice of such iten is also filled in accordance with subsection (i) in the State in which such residence is located.

Mestiling: PGROG. • In the case any notice of lien, the term "required railling period" means-(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 5 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the preceding required railling period for such notice of lien.

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lien. - if a notice of lienhas been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
