24 change of address/employment within 10 days.

25 11. — It is further ordered that:

26 (1) Defendant's \$100.00 monthly child
27 support obligation shall be due on the 1st day of
28 September, 1989, and shall continue due on the
1st day of each month thereafter until further
order of this Court.

(2) Defendant's \$100.00 monthly payment shall
be due on or before the 1st day of each month.

(3) That when defendant's minor
child/ren emancipate/s, defendant shall
continue to pay \$100.00 per month toward
satisfaction of then existing child support
arrears.

1 (4) That defendant's monthly child support
2 payments shall be in the form of a cashier's check,
3 certified check, or money order, or in cash. If the
4 payment is in the form of cash, it must be delivered
5 to the Douglas County Clerk at her office in Minden,
6 Nevada. If the payment is in the form of a cashier's
7 check, certified check, or money order, it must be
8 made payable to the DOUGLAS COUNTY CLERK, must
9 contain the notation Case No. 21768 (SWEENEY), and
10 be either mailed to the Douglas County Clerk at
11 Post Office Box 218, Minden, Nevada 89423, or
12 delivered to said County Clerk at her office in
13 Minden, Nevada. The Douglas County Clerk shall
14 transmit said payments to Montana Child Support
15 Enforcement, Case No. 86001398, Non-afdc, P.O. Box
16 5595, Helena, Montana 59604.

17 5. This case is set for a review hearing on
18 Tuesday, August 28, 1990, for the purpose of
19 determining whether defendant then has the ability
20 to pay \$200.00 per month as ongoing child support,
21 and whether defendant then has the ability to pay
22 some amount toward satisfaction of child support
23 arrears.

24 12. X NOTICE: This is an income withholding order. Support
25 payments in arrears by 30 days may be withheld from income
26 without further order of any court or further application
27 for services.
