After considering all of the pleadings and papers on file herein, and good cause appearing, the Court finds and orders as follows:

AFTER CONSIDERING ALL OF THE EVIDENCE, THE COURT FINDS:

1. ___ That the defendant/respondent could not be located for service of process.
2. That the Court has jurisdiction of the parties and subject matter of this case.
3. ___ That the defendant/respondent is not obligated to pay support on the following grounds:

1 4. That the defendant/respondent is the parent of the

4 5. That the defendant/respondent owes a duty of support to
5 the following dependent/s:

7 6. That \$100.00 per Month is a reasonable amount of support
8 for defendant/respondent to pay.

9 7. That the defendant/respondent is in arrears in the
10 amount of \$1,400.00 through September 30, 1989.

11 8. That the defendant/respondent owes reimbursement in the
12 amount of _____ as of _____.

13 9. That the defendant/respondent's income is:

14 Gross Income \$7,868.79 for the tax year
15 Ending December 31, 1988.

16 10. The Court further finds that:

17 1) The Court has reviewed the information
18 provided by the parties and finds that the
19 defendant, Jeffrey Ellis Kirby, is presently paying
20 \$100.00 per month as ongoing child support, which
21 represents approximately 18% of his gross income,
22 based upon his 1988 Federal Income Tax Return.

23 2) The defendant is presently attempting to
24 improve his employment status and therefore a review
25 hearing will be set for October 9, 1990, for the
26 purpose of determining whether defendant has then
27 the ability to pay more than \$100.00 per month
28 ongoing child support.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. This petition and supporting documents be returned to the
initiating jurisdiction for location of the defendant/
respondent.

2. This case be dismissed.

3. That the defendant/respondent is the parent of the
following child/ren:

1 4. Judgment is entered in favor of plaintiff/petitioner
2 LANGE BURNETT and against defendant/respondent in
3 the amount of \$1,400.00 for arrearages.

4 5. Judgment is entered in favor of plaintiff/petitioner
5 _____ and against defendant/respondent
6 in the amount of _____ for reimbursement.

7 6. That defendant/respondent shall pay \$150.00 per month,
8 beginning October 30, 1989, to be paid as follows:

14 child(ren) as follows:

18 10. The defendant/respondent shall notify the Court of any
19 change of address/employment within 10 days.

20 11. It is further ordered that:

21 (1) Defendant's \$150.00 monthly child support
22 obligation shall be due on the 30th day of
23 October, 1989, and shall continue due on the
24 30th day of each month thereafter until further
order of this Court.

25 (2) Defendant's \$150.00 monthly payment shall be
due on or before the 30th day of each month.

26 (3) That when defendant's minor child/ren
27 emancipate/s, defendant shall continue to pay
\$100.00 per month toward satisfaction of then
existing child support arrears.

28 (4) That defendant's monthly child support
payments shall be in the form of a cashier's check,

1 certified check, or money order, or in cash. If the
2 payment is in the form of cash, it must be delivered
3 to the Douglas County Clerk at her office in Minden,
4 Nevada. If the payment is in the form of a cashier's
5 check, certified check, or money order, it must be
6 made payable to the DOUGLAS COUNTY CLERK, must
7 contain the notation Case No. 19857 (KIRBY), and be
8 either mailed to the Douglas County Clerk at Post
9 Office Box 218, Minden, Nevada 89423, or
10 delivered to said County Clerk at her office in
11 Minden, Nevada. The Douglas County Clerk shall
12 transmit said payments to Court Trustee (RSL 194183)
13 P.O. Box 3544, Terminal Annex, Los Angeles, CA
14 90051.

5) This case shall be heard before the Court
on October 9, 1990, for the purpose of determining
whether defendant has then the ability to pay more
than \$100.00 per month as ongoing child support.

12. X NOTICE: This is an income withholding order. Support
payments in arrears by 30 days may be withheld from income
without further order of any court or further application
for services.
