Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unlass another date is specifically fixed by law, the fien imposed by section 8321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgement against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

- (a) Purchaser's Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgement Lien Creditors. - The Ilan imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgement lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (I) has been filled by the Secretary.

- (C) With Recorder Ol Deeds Of The District Of Columbia In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of Columbia.
 - (2) Silus Of Property Subject To Lien For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be
 - (A) Real Property In the case of real property, at its hysical location; or
 - (B) Personal Property In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxpayer at the time the notice of lien is filled.

For purposes of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or partnership shall be deemed to be the place at which the

or partnership shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal executive office of the business is located, and the residence of a taxpayer whose residence is without the United States shall be deemed to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - The form and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid notwithstanding any other provision of law regarding the form or content of a notice of the notice of flen.
