NOW THEREFORE, the said SAM M. FRANKOVICH, an unmarried man

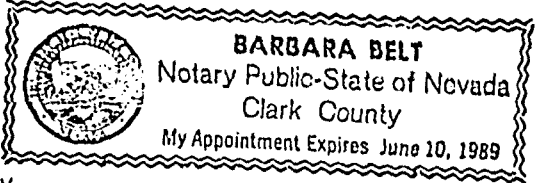
