ORDER TO CEASE, DESIST AND REFRAIN

WHEREAS, Chapter 119A of Nevada Revised Statutes and Chapter 119A of the Nevada Administrative Code provide that no person may offer or participate in the offer or advertisement of a time share in this state which has not been approved by the Nevada Division of Real Estate; and

WHEREAS, the Administrator has reason to believe that Kingsbury Crossing Owner's Association ("the Association") has solicited persons in Nevada to purchase a time share at a resort known as Kingsbury Crossing, more particularly described as follows:

> The land is situated in the State of Nevada, County of Douglas.

All that certain lot, piece or parcel of land situate in the County of Douglas, State of Nevada, being a portion of the North 1/2 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 26 Township 13 North, Range 18, East, M.D.B.&M., described as follows:

Parcel 3, as shown on that amended Parcel Map for John E. WHEREAS, in the opinion of the Administrator that in order to avoid irreparable harm to the public interest, a CEASE AND DESIST ORDER should be issued forthwith.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Department of Commerce, Division of Real Estate, that the above-named Kingsbury Crossing Owner's Association and each of its officers, agents and employees, CEASE, DESIST AND REFRAIN from the use of any offering or advertisement of time shares until such time as it has applied for and received a permit to engage in such activities.


