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Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgement against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforce able by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. -

The lien imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgement lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (I) has been filed by the Secretary.

(i) Place For Filing Notice; Form -

(1) Place For Filing . The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed -

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the country, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the taws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; except that State law merely conforming to reenacting Federal taw establishing a national filing system does not constitute a second office for filing as designated by the laws of such State; or

(8) With Clerk Of District Court - In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the

State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraps (A), or (C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia - In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of Columbia

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property stall be deemed to be situated (A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its physical location, or

(1) Form - The form and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid notwithstanding any other provision of law

regarding the form or content of a notice of lien.

- (g) Refiling Of Notice. For purposes of this section .
- (1) General Rule. Untess notice of tien is retiled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required retiting period, such notice of fier shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filed (in accurrance with subsection (f) after the expression of such reliting period.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property

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(a) Release Of Lien. -Subject regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable . The secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, logether with all interest in respect therol, has been fully satisfied

or has become legally unenforceable; or (2) Bond Accepted. There is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect therof, within the time prescribed by law (including any extension of such time), and that is in accordance with such requirements relating to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and sureties thereon, as may be specified by such regulations

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return

Information.

(k) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes.

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lien. notice of lien has been filed pursuant to section 6323(1), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
