

- 1) The subject easement shall revert to the abutting property owners as prescribed within Chapter 278.480 of the Nevada Revised Statues.
- 2) This abandonment is solely for the release of the public roadway interest, and it is hereby confirmed that a Public Utility Easement embracing the limits of the original roadway is expressly reserved for the continuation, maintenance, expansion, and operation of the public utilities contained within the limits of this abandonment.
