17 ORDER SETTLING FIRST AND FINAL REPORT OF
18 EXECUTRIX ON WAIVER OF ACCOUNT, FOR ALLOWANCE OF
STATUTORY COMMISSIONS AND FEES AND FOR FINAL DISTRIBUTION

19 ERIN DUNNE SAMMUT, as Executrix of the Will of JOSEPH E. DUNNE,
20 JR., deceased, having filed herein her first and final report and
21 petition for settlement thereof on waiver of account and petition
22 for final distribution of the estate herein, and the petition coming
23 on this day regularly for hearing, the Court finds:

24 1. Due and legal notice of the hearing of the petition has
25 been regularly given for the period and in the manner required by
26 law.

1 2. The report of the Executrix constitutes a full, true and
2 correct statement of her administration, and all the allegations of
3 the Petition for its settlement are true. The report should be
4 settled, allowed and approved as filed, and acts and transactions of
5 the Executor relating to the matters set forth in it should be
6 ratified, confirmed and approved.

7 3. JOSEPH E. DUNNE died testate on July 17, 1990, in
8 Vacaville, in the County of Solano, State of California, and was a
9 resident of the County of San Mateo.

10 4. On September 7, 1990, petitioner was appointed the
11 Executrix of decedent's Will dated April 19, 1989, qualified as
12 Executrix and ever since has been and now is the Executrix thereof.

13 5. Notice of death has been published for the period and in
14 the manner prescribed by law, and the estate is now in a condition
15 to be closed.

16 6. No claims were filed or presented against the estate. All
17 debts of the decedent and estate except attorney's fees and nominal
18 closing costs are paid.

19 7. An Inventory and Appraisement of the estate has been
20 returned and filed showing the total value of the estate to be
21 \$151,600.

22 8. There is no inheritance tax due the State of California.
23 All personal property taxes due and payable by this estate have been
24 paid.

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1 9. No federal estate tax return has been filed as this estate
2 is not sufficient to require such return, and no Federal Estate Tax
3 is due or payable.

4 10. All California or federal income taxes payable by this
5 estate have been or will be paid.

6 11. The estate is the separate property of the decedent.

7 12. Petitioner, ERIN DUNNE SAMMUT, and DIERDRE DUNNE LANDUCCI,
8 PATRICK M. DUNNE and MICHAEL COLLOM, all the persons entitled to
9 distribution of the residue of the estate, have waived an
10 accounting. Their Waivers have been filed herein.

11 13. The commissions provided by law for Petitioner's services
12 are \$4,182. Petitioner should be authorized to pay herself that sum
13 in discharge of statutory commissions.

14 14. NORMAN W. KAVANAUGH, attorney for petitioner, has rendered
15 ordinary legal services in the administration of this estate and as
16 petitioner's attorney, and the fee provided by law for such services
17 is \$4,182. Petitioner should be authorized and directed to pay her
18 attorney that sum in discharge of the statutory fee.

19 15. The devisees and legatees under the decedent's Will are:

20 GEORGIA RUHLAND, Trustee for
21 SHAWNA COLLOM and SANDI COLLOM
22 DIERDRE DUNNE LANDUCCI
23 ERIN DUNNE SAMMUT
24 PATRICK M. DUNNE
25 MICHAEL COLLOM

26 16. The only assets remaining in the estate are the Note in
the amount of \$150,000 secured by Deed of Trust and the three-wheel
scooter. The real property securing the Note is being sold and when

1 the estate is ordered distributed the Note may have been converted
2 to cash.

3 17. Decedent's Will provided a legacy of TWENTY THOUSAND
4 DOLLARS to GEORGIA RUHLAND, in trust for SHAWNA COLLOM and SANDI
5 COLLOM. This legacy will be paid from the proceeds to the Note.

6 18. No request for special notice has been filed.

7 19. Distribution should be ordered as hereafter specified.

8 IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that:

9 1. The administration of the estate is brought to a close.

10 2. The First and Final Report of the Executrix is settled,
11 allowed and approved as filed.

12 3. All the acts and transactions of the Executrix relating to
13 the matters set forth in the petition and report are ratified,
14 confirmed and approved.

15 4. Petitioner is authorized and directed to pay herself and
16 to pay her attorney, NORMAN W. KAVANAUGH, the sum of \$4,182 each as
17 statutory fees and commissions for their services rendered in the
18 administration of this estate.

19 5. After payment of costs of administration and pursuant to
20 the Will of decedent, Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) plus
21 interest at 7% per annum from July 17, 1991, to date of payment is
22 distributed to GEORGIA RUHLAND in trust for SHAWNA COLLOM and SANDI
23 COLLOM, to be used for them or distributed to them in her
24 discretion.


25 6. The residue of the estate consisting of the three-wheel
