ERIN DUNNE SAMMUT, as Executrix of the Will of JOSEPH E. DUNNE, JR., deceased, having filed herein her first and final report and petition for settlement thereof on waiver of account and petition for final distribution of the estate herein, and the petition coming on this day regularly for hearing, the Court finds:

1. Due and legal notice of the hearing of the petition has been regularly given for the period and in the manner required by law.

- 2. The report of the Executrix constitutes a full, true and correct statement of her administration, and all the allegations of the Petition for its settlement are true. The report should be settled, allowed and approved as filed, and acts and transactions of the Executor relating to the matters set forth in it should be ratified, confirmed and approved.
- 3. JOSEPH E. DUNNE died testate on July 17, 1990, in Vacaville, in the County of Solano, State of California, and was a resident of the County of San Mateo.

16. The only assets remaining in the estate are the Note in the amount of \$150,000 secured by Deed of Trust and the three-wheel scooter. The real property securing the Note is being sold and when

the estate is ordered distributed the Note may have been converted to cash.

- 17. Decedent's Will provided a legacy of TWENTY THOUSAND DOLLARS to GEORGIA RUHLAND, in trust for SHAWNA COLLOM and SANDI COLLOM. This legacy will be paid from the proceeds to the Note.
  - 18. No request for special notice has been filed.
  - 19. Distribution should be ordered as hereafter specified.

    IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that:
    - 1. The administration of the estate is brought to a close.
- 2. The First and Final Report of the Executrix is settled, allowed and approved as filed.
- 3. All the acts and transactions of the Executrix relating to the matters set forth in the petition and report are ratified, confirmed and approved.
- 4. Petitioner is authorized and directed to pay herself and to pay her attorney, NORMAN W. KAVANAUGH, the sum of \$4,182 each as statutory fees and commissions for their services rendered in the administration of this estate.
