14 On November 4, 1996, at 10:00 a.m., this Court  
 15 conducted a hearing to have Defendant STEVEN DALE SMITH, show  
 16 cause why he should not be held in contempt of court for  
 17 failing to pay his court-ordered child support. Gary L.  
 18 Kendrick, Deputy District Attorney, appeared on behalf of  
 19 Plaintiff KAREN GAYLE SMITH, and Defendant appeared with  
 20 Counsel Patrick B. Walsh. After hearing the evidence and  
 21 arguments of the parties, this Court enters the following  
 22 findings, order, and judgment.

FINDINGS

24

25 1. Defendant is the father of STEPHANIE NICOLE  
 SMITH, born 08/18/89, and DALTON GARRETT SMITH, born 02/01/93.

27 2. On March 20, 1996, Defendant was ordered to pay  
 28 \$300.00 per month per child for a total of \$600.00 per month  
 as ongoing child support beginning March 1, 1996. Defendant

1 was further ordered to provide health insurance for the  
2 parties' minor children in addition to his ongoing child  
3 support obligation.

4 3. That since the Court's entry of order on March  
5 20, 1996, Defendant has accrued child support arrearages of  
6 \$3,600.00 through and including November 3, 1996.

7 4. Defendant is self-employed as an Electrical  
8 Contractor in Douglas County, Nevada.

9 5. Defendant is capable of paying his court-ordered  
10 child support.

11 6. Defendant is in contempt of court for failing to  
12 pay his court-ordered child support.

13  
14 ORDER

15  
16 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Defendant serve 10 days in  
17 the Douglas County Jail for his Contempt of Court.

18 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the full 10 days are  
19 suspended on the condition that Defendant pay the sum of  
20 \$650.00 per month to be applied as follows: \$600.00 as ongoing  
21 child support and \$50.00 toward satisfaction of child support  
22 arrearages on or before the first of each month beginning  
23 December 1, 1996. The December 1, 1996, payment date is set  
24 with the understanding that Defendant will pay \$1,000.00 to the  
25 District Attorney's Office by November 8, 1996, which will  
26 reduce Defendant's arrears to \$2,600.00.

27 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Defendant keep the  
28 Douglas County District Attorney's Office informed of

1 Defendant's change in residence, mailing address, telephone, or  
2 employment within 10 days of any such change.

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Defendant provide  
4 health insurance for his minor children.

5 IT IS FINALLY ORDERED that should Defendant fail to  
6 make his \$650.00 per month ongoing child support and arrearage  
7 payment by the first of every month a bench warrant shall  
8 immediately be issued.

9  
10 JUDGMENT

11 Judgment is hereby entered in favor of Plaintiff and  
12 against Defendant in the amount of \$3,600.00 through November  
13 3, 1996.
