Gary Deputy District \ Attorney, appeared on Plaintiff KAREN GAYLE SMITH, and Defendant appeared Counsel Patrick B. Walsh. After hearing the evidence arguments of the parties, this Court enters the following findings, order, and judgment.

FINDINGS

- 1. Defendant is the father of STEPHANIE NICOLE SMITH, born 08/18/89, and DALTON GARRETT SMITH, born 02/01/93.
- 2. On March 20, 1996, Defendant was ordered to pay \$300.00 per month per child for a total of \$600.00 per month as ongoing child support beginning March 1, 1996. Defendant

further ordered was to provide health insurance for the parties' minor children in addition to his ongoing child support obligation.

- That since the Court's entry of order on March 20, 1996, Defendant has accrued child support arrearages of \$3,600.00 through and including November 3, 1996.
- 4. Defendant is self-employed as an Electrical Contractor in Douglas County, Nevada.
- Defendant is capable of paying his court-ordered 5. child support.
- Defendant is in contempt of court for failing to 6. pay his court-ordered child support.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Defendant serve 10 days in the Douglas County Jail for his Contempt of Court.

IS FURTHER ORDERED that the full $\mathbf{I}\mathbf{T}$ 10 days are suspended on the condition that Defendant pay the \$650.00 per month to be applied as follows: \$600.00 as ongoing child support and \$50.00 toward satisfaction of child support arrearages on or before the first of each month beginning December 1, 1996. The December 1, 1996, payment date is set with the understanding that Defendant will pay \$1,000.00 to the District Attorney's Office by November 8, 1996, which will reduce Defendant's arrears to \$2,600.00.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Defendant keep the Douglas County District Attorney's Office informed of

Defendant's change in residence, mailing address, telephone, or employment within 10 days of any such change.

FURTHER ORDERED that the Defendant provide IS health insurance for his minor children.

IT IS FINALLY ORDERED that should Defendant fail to make his \$650.00 per month ongoing child support and arrearage payment by the first of every month a bench warrant shall immediately be issued.

JUDGMENT

Judgment is hereby entered in favor of Plaintiff and against Defendant in the amount of \$3,600.00 through November 3, 1996.
