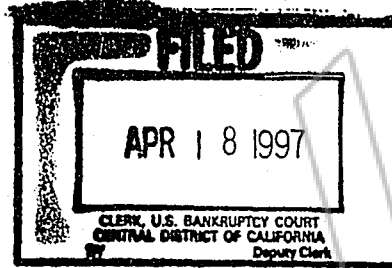

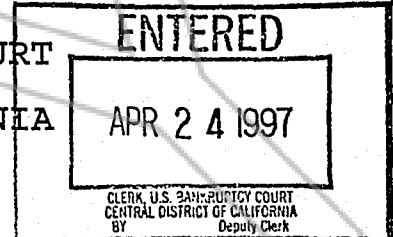

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Application is approved


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
1 and further thereto Debtor is authorized to compromise the
