COMES NOW, Plaintiff KAREN HEDY HURZEL, by and through GARY L. KENDRICK, DEPUTY DISTRICT ATTORNEY, and Defendant, EDWARD MARTIN SILVA II, who hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

1. That in an Order modifying Decree of Divorce filed February 1, 1993, in the Ninth Judicial District Court of the State of Nevada, In and For Douglas County, Defendant was ordered to pay the sum of 25% of his gross monthly income per month as ongoing support of his minor children, JONATHAN EDWARD SILVA Born: 09/13/85; and CHRISTOPHER MARTIN SILVA Born: 08/23/87.

2. That Defendant owes \$3,766.77 in child support arrearages through and including August 31, 1997.

3. That Defendant currently earns \$1,239.15, average per month. That based upon Defendant's monthly income and applying the formulas set forth in NRS 125B.070, to wit: 25%, Defendant's monthly child support obligation is \$309.00.

- 4. That Defendant is currently seeking full-time employment, and the parties' agree that a financial review shall be held in the District Attorney's Office on or about 9:30 am, on October 14, 1997, or as soon thereafter as is practicable.
- 5. The parties stipulate and certify that the amount of support is consistent with the appropriate formula set forth in paragraph (b) of subsection 1 of NRS 125B.070.
- 6. That the Defendant shall pay \$309.00 per month as ongoing support, plus \$25.00 per month toward satisfaction of child support arrears for a total of \$334.00 per month. That Defendant's first \$334.00 monthly payment shall be due on September 1, 1997, and continue due on the first day of each and every month thereafter until further order of this court.
- That Defendant's child support payments shall be made by wage withholding.
- 8. Defendant understands that, in the event he becomes unemployed or underemployed, all child support payments to be made by him to Plaintiff must be in the form of a cashier's check, certified check, or money order, or in cash. The Defendant further understands that if the payment is in the form of cash it must be delivered to the Douglas County Clerk at her office in Minden, Nevada. If the payment is in the form of a cashier's check, certified check, or money order, Defendant

understands that it must be made payable to the DOUGLAS COUNTY CLERK, with the notation Case No. 940287 (EDWARD MARTIN SILVA II), and be either mailed to the Douglas County Clerk at Post Office Box 218, Minden, Nevada 89423, or delivered to said County Clerk at her office in Minden, Nevada.

- 9. That the Defendant shall provide medical insurance coverage for his minor children if available through employment or other group policy.
- 10. That pursuant to NRS 125B.080.7, expenses for health care which are not reimbursed through insurance, including expenses for medical, surgical, dental, orthodontic and optical expenses, must be borne equally by both parents in the absence of extraordinary circumstances.
- 11. Defendant agrees that he shall notify the Douglas County District Attorney's Office in writing within 10 days of any change in Defendant's mailing address, home address, or employment.
- 12. Defendant understands that this support order may be reviewed every three years at the request of either party in accordance with NRS 125B.145.
- 13. Defendant understands that failure to pay his support as required by the order entered in accordance with this stipulation will subject him to possible contempt of court with a penalty of 25 days in jail.
