Gary L. 17 Kendrick, Deputy District Attorney, appeared on behalf 18 Plaintiff KAREN GAYLE SMITH, and Defendant who was in custody 19 on a Bench Warrant issued August 5, 1997, appeared 20 counsel. After hearing the evidence and arguments of the 21 parties, this Court enters the following findings, order, and 22 judgment. 23 **FINDINGS** 24 1. Defendant is the father of STEPHANIE NICOLE 25 SMITH, born 08/18/89, and DALTON GARRETT SMITH, born 02/01/93. 26 On March 20, 1996, Defendant was ordered to pay 2. 27 \$300.00 per month per child for a total of \$600.00 per month 28 as ongoing child support beginning March 1, 1996. was further ordered to pro	ovide health insurance for the

support obligation.	
3. That on Nov	ember 4, 1996, a hearing was
conducted to have the Defendant show cause why he should not be	
held in contempt of court for failing to pay his court ordered	

3. That on November 4, 1996, a hearing was conducted to have the Defendant show cause why he should not be held in contempt of court for failing to pay his court ordered child support. Defendant was found to be capable of paying his child support and was held in contempt of court for failing to pay as ordered. The Defendant was sentenced to 10 days in the Douglas County Jail. The Defendant's 10 day sentence was suspended upon the condition that the Defendant pay his ongoing and arrearage payments totaling \$650.00 beginning December 1, 1996, and on the first day of each month thereafter.

4. That the Defendant failed to pay his child support as ordered by this Court on November 13, 1996.

5. That since the Court's entry of order on March 20, 1996, Defendant has accrued child support arrearages of \$4,925.25 through and including September 14, 1997.

- 6. Defendant is employed as an Electrician.
- 7. Defendant is capable of paying his court-ordered child support.
- 8. Defendant is in contempt of court for failing to pay his court-ordered child support.

## ORDER

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IT IS **HEREBY** ORDERED Defendant that serve additional 15 days in the Douglas County Jail for his Contempt of Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the full 15 days are suspended on the condition that Defendant the pay sum of \$650.00 per month to be applied as follows: \$600.00 as ongoing child support and \$50.00 toward satisfaction of Defendant's child support arrearages on or before the first of each month beginning October 1, 1997.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Defendant be released from custody and given credit for 6 days time served with 4 remaining suspended from this Court's previous order of November 13, 1996. Defendant will therefore have a total of 19 suspended upon the condition that he make his support payments as ordered herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Defendant provide the District Attorney's Office with proof of Defendant's current income, Defendant's tax return and W-2. Upon a showing of substantial change in circumstances warranting a modification of Defendant's child support obligation, this matter shall be remanded to the Hearing Master for a formal review. If it is determined by the District Attorney's Office that no substantial change of circumstance has occurred, Defendant's child support obligation shall remain as currently ordered.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Defendant keep the County District Attorney's Office informed Douglas of Defendant's change in residence, mailing address, telephone, or employment within 10 days of any such change.

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IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Defendant provide health insurance for his minor children.

IT IS FINALLY ORDERED that should Defendant fail to make his \$650.00 per month ongoing child support and arrearage payment by the first day of every month, a bench warrant shall immediately be issued.

## JUDGMENT

Judgment is hereby entered in favor of Plaintiff and against Defendant in the amount of \$4,925.25 through September 14, 1997.
